



Student Registration for September 2008

Kindergarten Students

Children who will be five years of age before January 1, 2009, may enter school in September 2008. You may defer your child's enrolment until September 2009.

You are encouraged to register your child at your neighbourhood (catchment) school as soon as you can. Please bring your child's birth certificate. To obtain an assured space in your catchment-area school, you must register by June 15, 2008.

Grades 1 to 12 Students New to the School District

If you will be new to the school district in September 2008, register your child at your neighbourhood (catchment) school as early as possible. To obtain an assured space in your catchment-area school, you must register by June 15, 2008.

New Kindergarten and Grade One Early French Immersion Students

In-district and out-of-district French Immersion registration will start on Monday, March 3, 2008 and continue until Friday, March 14, 2008 at the French Immersion school of your choice. Spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis with priority given to students who have a sibling already registered in the school for September 2008 classes. Where space permits, new out-of-district applications for Early French Immersion will be accepted after consideration of all in-district applications received prior to June 15, 2008.

New Out-of-Catchment and Out-of-District Students

The application process is currently underway and will continue until Friday, March 28, 2008. Please complete an application form at the school you wish to attend.

Important Notice for ALL Continuing Out-of-District Students

All continuing out-of-district students must confirm their registration for next year by submitting a form to the current school of attendance by Friday, March 28, 2008.

New Elementary Learn-at-Home Students

New registration for in-district and out-of-district elementary Learn-at-Home students will start on Monday, March 3, 2008 and continue until Friday, March 14, 2008 at Forest Park Elementary. Spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis with priority given to those who have a sibling already registered in the program for September 2008. Where space permits, new out-of-district applications for Learn-at-Home K-7, will be considered after all in-district applications received prior to June 15, 2008 are accommodated.

New Registration for Grades 8 to 12 Soccer and Hockey Academy *(Subject to fee approval process)*

New registration for Grades 8 to 12 Soccer and Hockey Academy students will begin at Woodlands Secondary School on Monday, March 3, 2008 and continue until Friday, March 14, 2008. Where space permits, new out-of-district applications for the Soccer and Hockey Academy will be considered after all in-district applications received prior to June 15, 2008 are accommodated.

New Registration for Grades 8 to 12 Performing Arts Academy

New registration for Grades 8 to 12 Performing Arts Academy students will begin at Dover Bay Secondary School on Monday, March 3, 2008 and continue until Friday, March 14, 2008. Where space permits, new out-of-district applications for the Performing Arts Academy will be considered after all in-district applications received prior to June 15, 2008 are accommodated. Applicants will be notified of audition dates.

New Registration for Grades 11 and 12 Jazz Academy

New registration for Grades 11 and 12 Jazz Academy students will begin at Wellington Secondary School on Monday, March 3, 2008 and continue until Friday, March 14, 2008. Where space permits, new out-of-district applications for the Jazz Academy will be considered after all in-district applications received prior to June 15, 2008 are accommodated.
